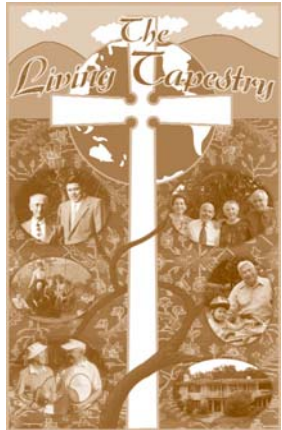


The Living Tapestry Benevolence Fund
